A			Ordinary combustible materials	Wood, fabric, paper, plastic, trash and rubber
B			Flammable liquids and gases	Gasoline, petroleum oil, paint, propane, butane, solvents, oils and alcohol
C			Energized electrical appliances	Computers, faxes, motors, transformers and appliances
D			Combustible metals	Magnesium, titanium, sodium, aluminum, lithium and potassium
K			Cooking oils and greases	Oils, animal and vegetable fats
